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June 11, 2008 (Katonah, New York) Contemporary folk-pop singer/songwriter **Sloan Wainwright** – youngest sister to folk-music luminary Loudon Wainwright, and the aunt to the next generation of Wainwright artists, Rufus, Martha and Lucy – releases new CD project **Rediscovery**. This new work is a collection of hand picked cover tunes, a musical rediscovery of, and reconnection to, ten songs that have inspired and influenced the artist throughout her career.

Stand out tracks include the fan-favorite 'Ring of Fire', a sweetly pretty version of Marvin Gaye's 'Mercy Me/The Ecology', a poignant version of John Lennon's 'Love' and a stark, soulful interpretation of Neil Young's 'After The Gold Rush'. *Rediscovery* is available for sale at all live shows and can be purchased online through CDBaby.com.

Defying standard categorization, singer/songwriter Sloan Wainwright consistently demonstrates her easy command of a variety of American musical styles: pop, folk, jazz and blues held together by the melodious tone of her rich contralto with the end result a unique and soulful hybrid.
